1 Revision History

When Ennov releases a new version of Ennov InSight, they issue Release Notes which explain the new features and updates. The Ennov Business Consulting Team reviews the Release Notes against each Best Practice to determine any impact to the document:

- Impact = Release notes-documented upgrade changes this Best Practice
- No Impact = Release notes-documented upgrade changes do not affect this Best Practice

When Release Notes impact Best Practice documentation, Ennov recommends that clients review the entire Release Notes for a full understanding of all changes associated with this Best Practice documentation.

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3 Document Purpose

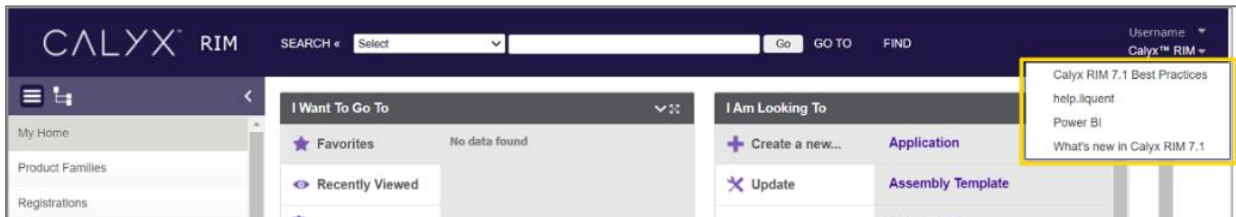
The purpose of this document is to provide a Best Practice guide defining the use of the Linked Systems feature in Ennov InSight.

4 Scope

The scope of the proposed document is the process for defining the details required for use of the Linked Systems feature in Ennov InSight.

5 Linked Systems feature

The Linked Systems feature is used to manage the links available in the drop-down menu below the username in the top-right corner of Ennov InSight. Clicking on 'Calyx RIM' displays the list of links as shown in the screenshot below. Linked Systems are displayed in alphabetical order.



The Linked Systems can be managed from Technical Administration by users with Technical Administrator access.

5.1 Manage Linked Systems

The example below shows the Linked System 'help.liquent'. The Display Name and URL can be set as desired.

The Linked System will be available to all users by default. Access can be limited to specific users by selecting Yes in "Limit Access to Specific Users" and then selecting a set of named users, groups, or roles. If a user is not granted access, the link will not be visible to them.

If the system should no longer be linked to Ennov InSight, the value can be deactivated.
